We are delighted to announce the opening of two new services in Blackburn

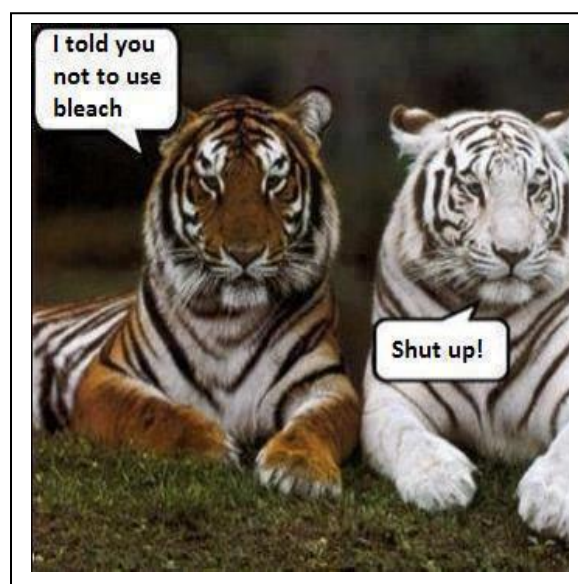
