These are just some of the exciting things we have been getting up to.

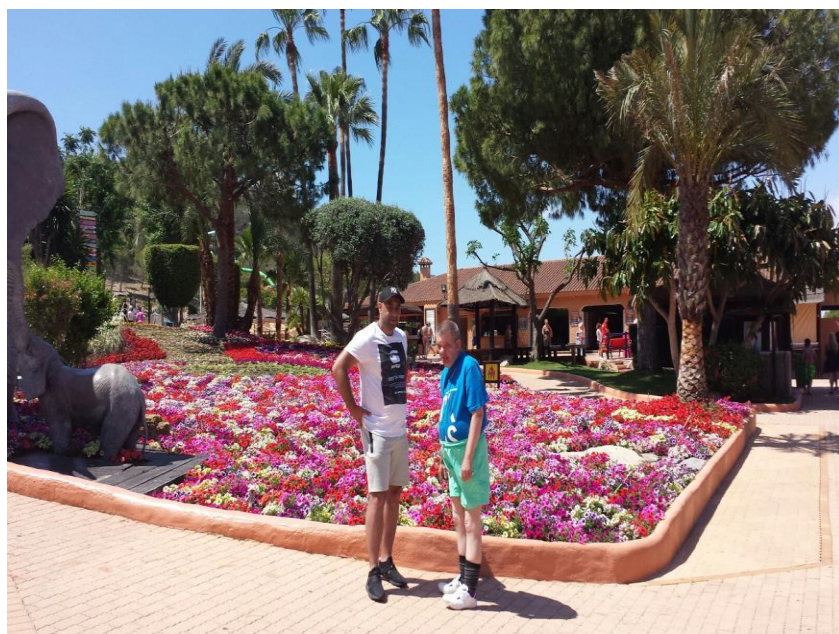

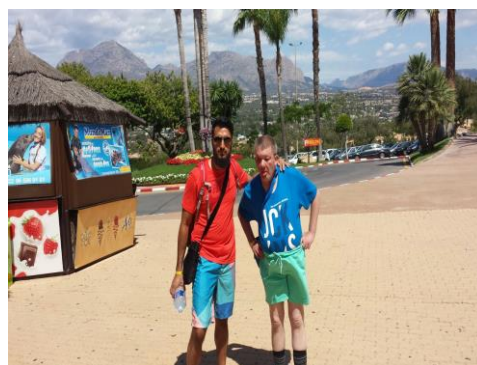

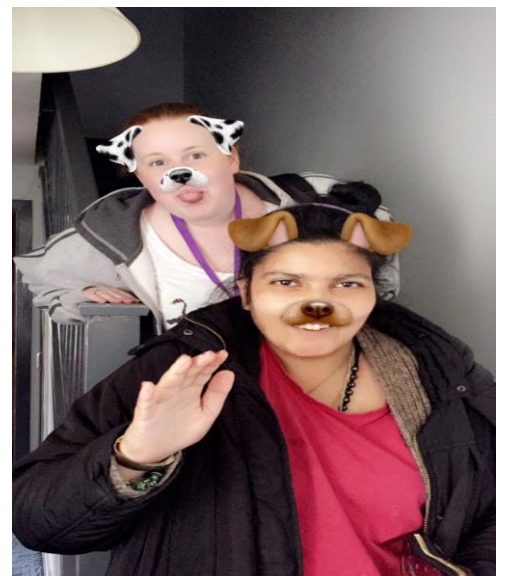
